Protect Yourself and Others Against the Flu

Influenza is a serious disease that can lead to hospitalization and sometimes even death. Even healthy people can get sick from the flu and spread it to others.



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that people get their flu vaccine as soon as it becomes available in the community. Vaccination before December is best to ensure that protective antibodies are established before flu activity is at its highest in January and February.

The flu vaccine is the best way to protect yourself and your family from the flu. **Walmart Pharmacy** will be hosting a convenient flu vaccination clinic at Transfiguration Catholic Church on **Saturday, October 14th** from **9:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M.** in the **Adult Lounge**. Payment of **\$30** for the quadrivalent flu vaccination will be accepted at time of service. This is **\$10 below the average cost of the quadrivalent flu shot** from your neighborhood pharmacies. Cash, check and credit card will be accepted. Most insurance plans, along with Medicare, will also be accepted as payment.

To qualify for a free flu vaccine through Medicare:

- ***Medicare must be your primary insurance***
- ***Medicare Part B is required.***

- ❖ **Flu vaccinations will be available for any one 13 years of age and over.**
(All children 13 to 17 years of age must have consent signed for by a parent or legal guardian.)
- ❖ **Pneumonia vaccinations will also be offered to those 65 and over, if not administered within the last 5 years.**
